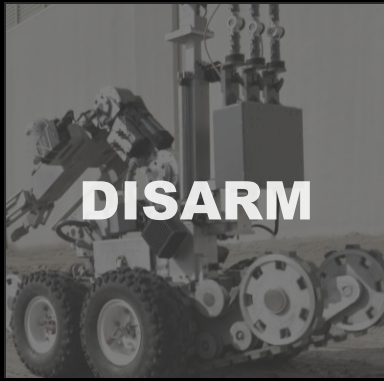


## EXPLOSIVE ORDNANCE DISPOSAL (EOD) QUALIFIED OFFICERS
