
Like any branch of the military, the U.S. Air Force goes where and when it is most needed, but getting to a theater of operations doesn't happen on its own.

#### WHAT WE DO | SAMPLE RESPONSIBILITIES & LEADERSHIP:

\* Direct distribution management operations, including transportation functions and shipping of supplies

\* Determine base readiness requirements and operational support capacity

\* Compute and analyze current and projected materiel requirements to support flying and other operations

- \* Direct contingency planning, fuels management, aerial port, and vehicle management operations
- \* Formulate logistics management and fiscal policy to sustain critical Air Force weapon systems
- \* Perform site surveys on worldwide airfields to validate for agile combat support
- \* Support rapid global mobility through the planning, preparation, and movement of personnel and equipment
- \* Work with our Allied Partners and sister services to ensure logistics support for operations anywhere at any time
