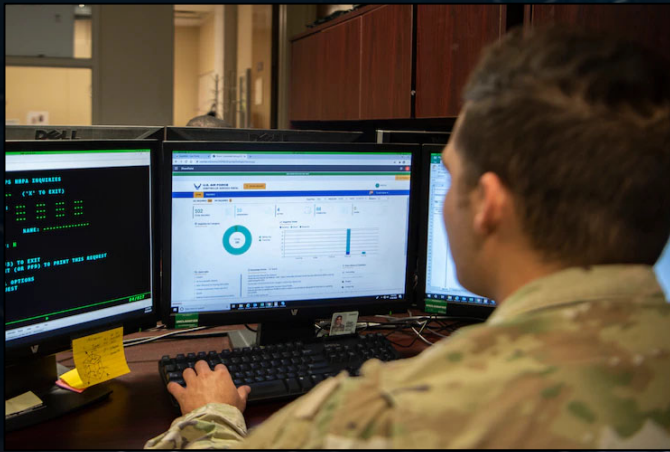

Qualification Summary

- Bachelor's Degree
- A minimum of 24 semester hours in the subjects of economics, accounting, finance, management and statistics
- Six hours must be in accounting
- Completion of Officer Training School (OTS), US Air Force Academy (USAFA) or Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC)
- Upon commissioning, must complete the Basic Financial Management Course (BFMC)

Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) Description

- The chief financial officer providing commanders, directors and decision makers with relevant, accurate and timely financial advice
- Officers are charged with ensuring resources are aligned with warfighting capabilities required to meet National Defense Strategy objectives
- Deliver budget, finance, and cost expertise to all levels of the DoD, to include Combatants Commands, Joint Staff, Air Staff, Space Staff, Major Commands, Field Commands, Wings, Deltas, Groups and Squadrons – fund the missions!
- Functions include developing, advocating and executing budgets to support mission operations; cost analysis to support major acquisition programs and resource decision-making to support the mission and senior leader priorities; military, civilian, and travel pay support to Airmen and Guardians; manage contract payments to support mission operations; analysis and studies to estimate cost and evaluate performance; and lead and develop cost, economic, and business case analyses
